

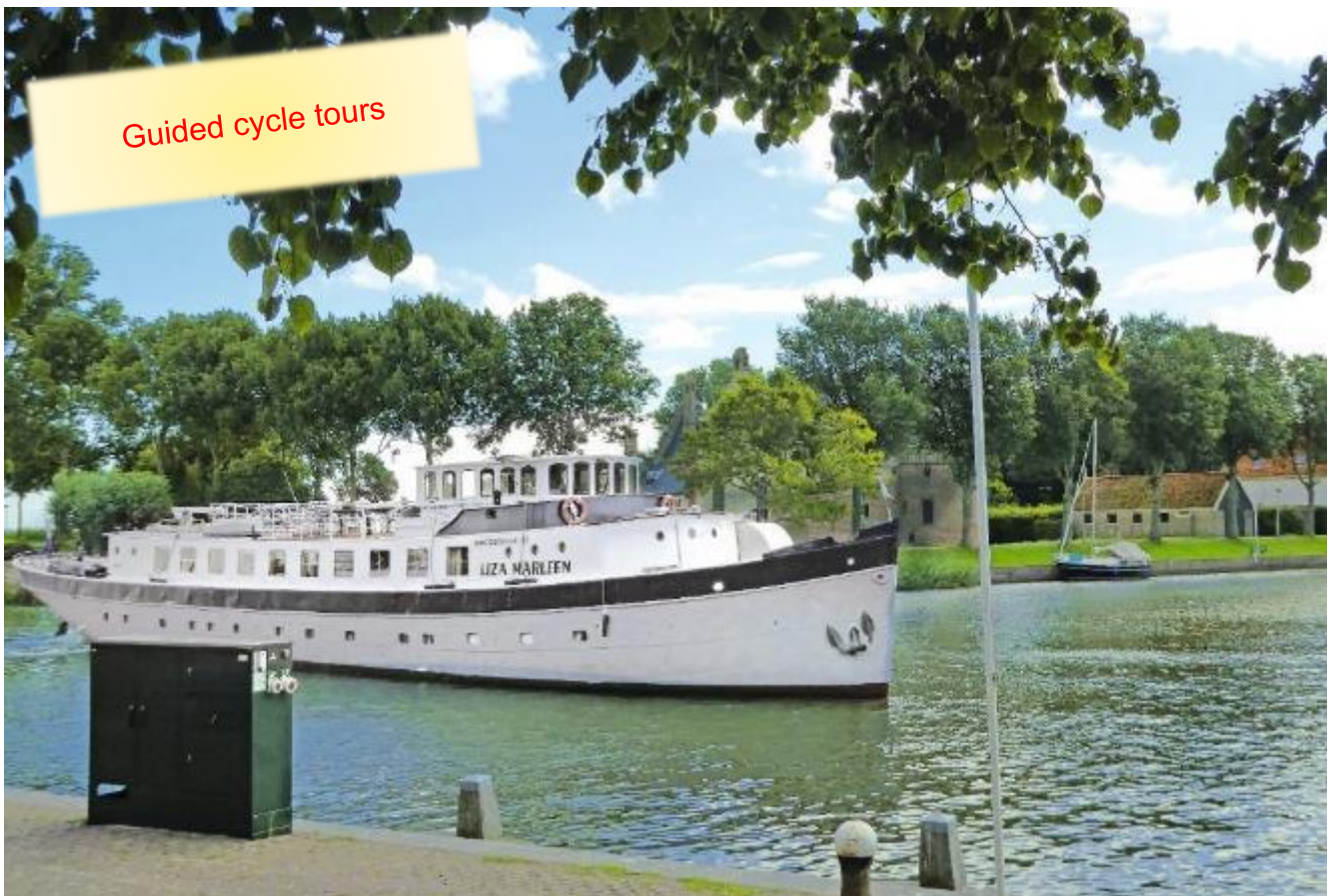

Day 1: Arrival in Bruges

Individual arrival in Bruges. Embarkation at 4:00 pm. Take some time to discover the interesting city of Bruges – The Venice of the North – is widely known in Europe for its art and museums. Bruges' old town with its number of Grachten (small channels) belongs to the UNESCO world's cultural heritage. Enjoy the bustle activity around the Grote Markt (the big market place) while having a nice tea or coffee.

Day 2: Trip around Bruges, cycle tour approx. 55 km

The cycling tour leads through the small town of Damme (known as the "birthplace" of Till Eulenspiegel) and Groot Ter Doest, with its impressive Ter Doest Abbey, to Lissewege – often called "the most beautiful village in Flanders." Whitewashed houses line both sides of a small canal and cluster around the imposing village church. Afterwards, the route continues directly to the coast. A long sandy beach and numerous cafés invite you to linger. After a stay of around 2 hours, return to Bruges.

Day 3: Bruges – Moerbrugge – Ghent (Merelbeke), cycle tour approx. 60 km

During breakfast your boat is shipping to Moerbrugge. The whole cycle route follows the Ghent-Oostende-Canal

through the wide Flemish plain to Ghent. In the Middle Ages Ghent was the second largest city after Paris and has preserved its architectural wealth in the historic city centre until today. Your ship will dock for the night in Merelbeke (at the lock), a suburb of Ghent and approx. 30 cycling minutes to the city centre.

Day 4: Ghent (Merelbeke) – Sint Amands, cycle tour approx. 65 km

After breakfast you are going by bike to Dendermonde today. A coffee break on the wonderful Flemish Grote Markt is a must. In the evening shipping to Sint Amands one of the most beautiful and winding parts of the route on the river Schelde.

Day 5: Sint Amands – Temse – Antwerp, cycle tour approx. 42 km

In Sint Amands you start today's cycle tour. You are passing the water tower and cross the Brussels-Rupel-canal. After that you are cycling through a historic area of brick burning, where bricks have been produced since the Middle Ages until today. Then you follow the river Rupel until you come to the river Schelde. From Rupelmonde you are comfortably cycling towards Hemiksem, then down the river Schelde to Antwerp, the world's centre of diamond-processing and your today's destination. Antwerp offers a number of interesting sights such as the richly decorated town hall in renaissance style, the historic Grote Markt, the huge Liebfrauen Cathedral and the medieval Steen Castle.

Day 6: Antwerp – Willebroek, cycle tour approx. 45 km

After breakfast you are starting your bike tour, passing the suburban of Antwerp with their beautiful exclusive residential area via Lier along the river Nete to Willebroek where your ship is already waiting for you.

Day 7: Willebroek – Mechelen – Vilvoorde, cycle tour approx. 40 km

While your ship is going through the Willebroek canal today, your last cycle tour is leading you through green, soft and hilly landscapes over Mechelen to Vilvoorde. In Mechelen, you will find the remarkable density of more than 300 listed buildings (classified as historical monuments), among them eight churches, all built within an area of only three square kilometres. From there, the journey continues to Vilvoorde, a charming suburb located about 10 km north of Brussels. Tip: You can reach Brussels by public transport in around 30 minutes. Use the afternoon to explore this fascinating city on your own – known for its diversity and cosmopolitan flair. (Distance from the mooring location to Vilvoorde train station: approx. 2 km. Train ticket to Brussels: approx. €4 per person.)

Day 8: Departure from Vilvoorde

After breakfast, disembarkation until 9:00 am and individual journey home.

Passenger car parking options in Bruges (subject to change)

Guarded parking areas at the main station (Stationsplein), approx. 7 € per day. Online reservation possible:

Transfer by taxi from Stationsplein to ship berth approx. 10-20 €. Return transfer by train from Brussels to Bruges approx. 18 € per person. Distance to the mooring location approx. 800 m. Transfer to the landing stage by taxi, approx. €10-20.

Please note: The return transfer from Vilvoorde back to Bruges must be organized individually. Train journey takes about 1 hour and costs approx. €20 per person. Tickets can be booked, for example, via Belgian Train: <https://www.belgiantrain.be/en?journey=0> (Vilvoorde train station is located approx. 2 km from the mooring location.)

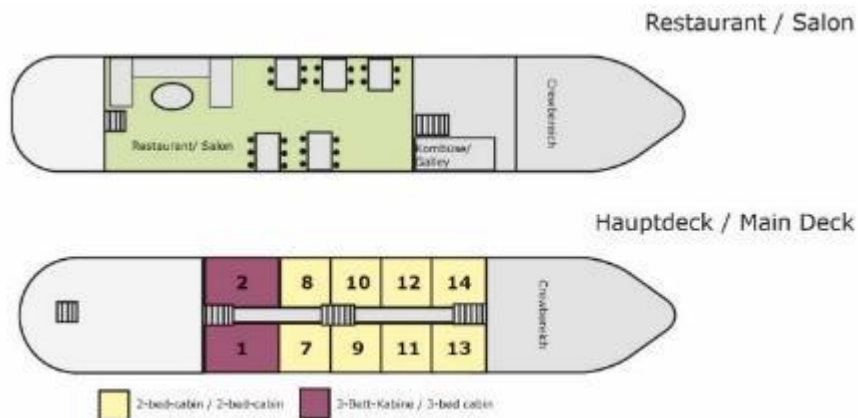

Between 1997/1998, Floor van Aemstel was newly constructed from a dismantled casco of a freight lugger, a common type of ship in the beginning of the 20th century. The refurbishing and conversion to a passenger ship was made in 2015/2016. The ship features a tastefully decorated saloon/restaurant with a huge, cosy sitting area, TV and stereo equipment and a small bar. The lower sun deck offers storage space for the bicycles, on the upper sun deck (steep stairs) there are sitting areas for the passengers.



Cabins

Eight 2-bed-cabins (about 10 m²) and two bigger 3-bed-cabins (15 m²), which can be booked also as twin cabins. All cabins are outside cabins with en-suite facilities. All are equipped with hair dryer and air-conditioning. The windows cannot be opened.



Important remarks

Embarkation from 4:00 p.m. | **Disembarkation** until 09:00 a.m.

Minimum number of participants 18 persons until 21 days prior to departure

To bring your own bike Due to limited space on the sun deck, it is not possible to bring your own bicycle on board.

Schedule and program changes Schedule and program changes are generally reserved. For example, if a section of the route cannot be sailed due to low or high water levels or adverse weather conditions, the captain reserves the right to change the itinerary for your safety. This does not constitute a valid reason for a free cancellation. The same applies to lock and/or bridge repairs ordered by authorities without prior notice.

Notes Please be aware that a cruise ship is not only your hotel but also a machine, working with engine power also during the night. Especially crossing locks and bridges - and the preparation work - may cause noise. If you are sensitive, please bring your own ear plugs. Lock passages may involve disruptions and cannot be avoided.

Travel documents EU-citizens (without special situations like dual citizenship, main residence abroad or a limited-validity passport) are required to have a valid passport or ID-card, not expiring within six (6) months of the return of your cruise. We kindly ask non-EU citizens, EU-nationals with multiple citizenship or anybody who has to respect special legal entry requirements for the country to visit, to inform about visa and entry documents at the competent embassy. **This trip is not suitable for guests with reduced mobility.** We recommend that **you take out a travel health insurance with repatriation coverage as well as baggage, accident and travel cancellation insurances.**
