From Koblenz, situated on the Deutsche Eck or German Corner, you will sail along the enchanting Moselle. Cruise via Cochem and Trier to the famous Great Saar Loop near Saarburg. On the way back to Koblenz, you will make a stop at the wine village of Bernkastel-Kues. Come on board and let these two rivers enchant

## Day 1 Koblenz

Individual arrival in Koblenz, situated at the mouth of the Rhine and Moselle River. Upon embarkation, our cruise management will welcome you aboard with a glass of sparkling wine.

## Day 2 Cochem

Enjoy a scenic cruise along the picturesque Moselle before reaching the pretty town of Cochem. Cochem Old Town impresses with half-timbered houses, picturesque squares, quaint alleys and the market square. Here we will offer an optional excursion with guided walk and a wine tasting. Not only will you learn interesting facts about the town and its sights but you will also be introduced to the Cochem wine culture. After the guided walking tour, sample local Moselle wines at one of the town's most scenic viewpoints.

## Day 3 Trier/Schweich

Trier is a city with many faces, which comes as no surprise considering its 2,000-year-old history. No less than 9 buildings have been added to the UNESCO World Heritage list. The special charm of the city lies in the seamless blend of old and new, which you can discover on an optional guided city walk. In the afternoon, you can join an outing to Luxembourg (optional): During the coach tour, you will get to know this cosmopolitan and forward-looking country, which has built up a reputation as one of the foremost international financial centres and as one of the institutional seats of the European Union. Furthermore, there are a lot of historic and cultural sites to explore. During the night, your ship continues the journey.

## Day 4 Saarburg

In the morning, you will reach Saarburg, also referred to as „Little Venice “. The town is characterised by narrow alleys, quaint half-timbered houses, Baroque buildings, and colourful fisherman's and boatman's houses. Join us on a guided walking tour (optional) and discover the historic wine town on the river Saar. Afterwards, indulge in a wine tasting where you can deepen your knowledge about the local wines. In the evening, the MS SE-Manon sets sail and heads towards Bernkastel-Kues.

## Day 5 Bernkastel-Kues

In the morning, you will reach the famous wine town on the Middle Mosel, which is also birthplace of the famous German philosopher Nikolaus of Cusa. In 1905, the town of Bernkastel, on the right bank, was merged with the village of Kues, on the left bank. On a panoramic tour, which includes a guided walk through the town as well as a coach tour through the Moselle valley, learn interesting and amusing facts. The excursion is rounded off with a wine tasting. Afterwards, enjoy your last evening on board at the traditional gala dinner.

## Day 6 Koblenz

After breakfast, disembarkation and individual journey home.

# Ship Details | Useful Information

## MS SE-MANON

On board our premium ship MS SE-MANON, you will enjoy a relaxed and cosy atmosphere.

After sightseeing, you can decide whether you prefer to use the small inviting spa area with sauna and whirlpool or curl up with a book in the small library. You may also choose to relax in the saloon with panoramic windows or on the sun deck.

In the restaurant, where panoramic windows offer stunning views over the passing scenery, will be served some fine food. You can round off the evenings in the saloon, having a glass of wine or beer and listening to relaxing music.

The spacious sun deck is partly shaded and features plenty of deck chairs and loungers.

A special highlight is the outdoor pool at the aft of the ship (8.70 m x 4.50 m, open approx. from May to August, depending on the weather).

There is an elevator running between the middle deck, the foyer and the restaurant. The upper deck and the sun deck are accessible by stair lift. The main deck is only accessible by stairs.


The ship is not wheelchair accessible. Smoking is only permitted on the sundeck, it is not permitted to smoke in any indoor area of the ship.

All 74 cabins are outside cabins (approx. 14 m<sup>2</sup>) and are comfortably furnished with hotel-style beds and ensuite facilities with shower\* (\*cabin 306, 307, 308, 309 with bathtub) featuring hair dryer, satellite TV, safe, internal telephone line, and individually adjustable air conditioning.

**Upper deck:** cabins featuring French balconies (= floor-to-ceiling sliding glass doors).

**Middle deck:** The huge panoramic windows can be opened.

**Main deck:** The small windows cannot be opened (Height approx. 40 cm).



## Important Notes

**Embarkation** from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm | **Disembarkation** from 9:00 am.

**Minimum Number of Participants** 80 participants within 21 days prior to departure

**Optional Excursion Program** We would be happy to send you an order form with our offer on excursions prior to departure.

The excursions will be held in German language. The excursions can only be booked in English language on request (depending on the excursion agency and the minimum number of participants).

**Itinerary and program are subject to change at any time.** If, for example, due to low or high water levels or bad weather conditions a route cannot be sailed, the captain reserves the right to alter the itinerary for your safety. (No legal right shall arise in either situation). The same shall apply for repair or maintenance works on locks and bridges ordered by river and other local authorities with little or no advance.

**Important notice** Please consider that on the one hand your ship is your holiday hotel, on the other hand, however, it is an engine that has to run constantly – even at night-time (this includes passing under bridges or through locks). We recommend that passengers that are particularly noise-sensitive, bring along earplugs. When passing through locks, a certain level of noise is inevitable. Please note: during low water conditions, it may become necessary to empty the pool to reduce the weight of the ship. As a result, the pool may not be accessible.

**Travel documents** EU-citizens (without special situations like dual citizenship, main residence abroad or a limited-validity passport) are required to have a valid passport or ID-card, not expiring within six (6) months of the return of your cruise. We kindly ask non-EU citizens, EU-nationals with multiple citizenship or anybody who has to respect special legal entry requirements for the country to visit, to inform about visa and entry documents at the competent embassy.

This trip is **not suitable for guests with reduced mobility**.

We recommend that you **take out a foreign travel health insurance** with repatriation coverage, an accident insurance, a luggage insurance and a travel cancellation insurance.
