1st Day: Bamberg – Embarkation

Individual arrival in Bamberg and embarkation from 4:00 p.m. onwards. Bamberg is a city full of character and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The "Island District" resembles a little Venice, the "Hill District" is often called the Franconian Rome, and the "Gardeners' District" is truly one of a kind.

2nd Day: Shipping Bamberg – Haßfurt / Haßfurt – Schweinfurt, Cycle tour approx. 30 - 40 km

In the morning, you arrive in Haßfurt with its charming historic old town. Nestled between two nature parks, the city is home to remarkable sacred buildings such as the late Gothic Knights' Chapel and the parish church, featuring sculptures by Tilman Riemenschneider. From here, you hop on your bike and ride to the former imperial city of Schweinfurt.

3rd Day: Schweinfurt – Volkach – Kitzing / Marktbreit, Cycle tour approx. 32 – 60 km

Today's destination is either Kitzingen or Marktbreit, depending on the final mooring confirmation. The historic wine trading town of Kitzingen is home to the German Carnival Museum, offering insights into a significant aspect of Franconian tradition. The town's landmark is the Falterturm, known for its distinctive crooked roof. In Kitzingen, a long history of brewing meets winemaking. Several local inns serve hearty Franconian specialties such as *Sauerbraten* with dumplings or "blue" carp. Alternatively, you can choose to stay on board until Volkach, which shortens the bike tour by approximately 25 kilometers.

4th Day: Kitzingen / Marktbreit – Würzburg, Cycle tour approx. 40 km

Today, Würzburg awaits you with many sights to explore. One of the highlights is the Würzburg Residence, considered one of Germany's most important palaces and a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1981. Other well-known landmarks include St. Kilian's Cathedral and Marienberg Fortress. Würzburg is also a center of Franconian wine culture and, as a vibrant university town, full of life even in the evenings.

5th Day: Shipping Würzburg – Karlstadt / Karlstadt – Lohr, Cycle tour approx. 30 km

In the late morning, you arrive in Karlstadt. Towers, gates, and old walls surround the historic center with its half-timbered houses and narrow alleyways. Today's destination is the town of Lohr am Main. Its old town, shaped by typical Franconian timber-frame architecture, marks the gateway to the Spessart hills. Buildings such as the Electoral Mainz Castle add to the town's fairy-tale charm.

6th Day: Shipping Lohr – Wertheim / Wertheim – Freudenberg, Cycle tour approx. 30 km

Your ship takes you to the residence city of Wertheim, with its impressive Castle as its landmark. This historic town, featuring a charming market square and what is said to be the narrowest house in Franconia, marks the starting point of today's bike stage to Freudenberg. Perched high above the Main River and the town, Freudenberg Castle sits at the edge of the Franconian Odenwald.

7th Day: Freudenberg – Aschaffenburg, Radtour ca. 50 km, Shipping Aschaffenburg – Frankfurt/Main

The highlight of today's bike tour is Miltenberg, home to the Miltenburg Castle, built in 1200. From Erlenbach to Kleinwallstadt, you follow the "Planet Cycle Path," offering interesting facts about the planets along the way. The riverside forest between Niedernheim and Nilkheim provides a pleasantly shaded route during summer. All along the Main River, you'll find benches and picnic spots that invite you to take a break—or even go for a swim.

Your destination is the charming university town of Aschaffenburg, known for its impressive Renaissance palace, Johannisburg Castle, built from red sandstone. The town also offers plenty of wine taverns, cafés, and traditional inns to enjoy. In the evening, a farewell dinner awaits you on board as your ship sails back to Frankfurt/Main.

8th Day: Departure from Frankfurt/Main

After breakfast checkout until 9:00 am— have a safe journey home.

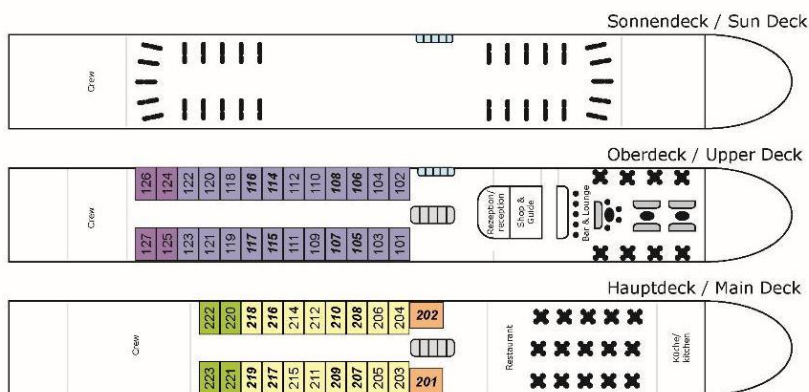
Cabins All 48 cabins are located on the outside of the ship and are equipped with a shower/WC, hairdryer, TV, safe (deposit required), minibar, onboard telephone, and individually adjustable air conditioning. In cabins with two single beds, one bed can be converted into a sofa during the day for added comfort. Cabins with a double bed (160x200 cm) have separate mattresses. All twin-bed cabins are approximately 12 m² in size.

Main Deck: A total of 22 cabins with panoramic windows that cannot be opened. 16 twin-bed cabins: eight with two single beds, eight with a double bed. Four Eco* twin-bed cabins with two single beds located in the rear of the ship. Two more spacious Deluxe cabins with a double bed located in the front of the ship.

Upper Deck: A total of 26 cabins with French balconies (= floor-to-ceiling windows that can be opened). 22 twin-bed cabins: 14 with two single beds, eight with a double bed. Four Eco* twin-bed cabins with two single beds located in the rear of the ship. * Engine and generator noise may be noticeable.

Embarkation from 4 pm | **Disembarkation** until 9 am.
Minimum number of participants 75 guests (must have been reached within 21 days prior to departure). **To bring your own bike** On request only – due to lack of space on sun deck. E-bikes exclusively with removable battery pack. We exclude any liability for loss, theft and damage - this also applies to damage caused by transportation from shore to ship or vice versa. **Excursions** We offer a small excursion program, that can be booked directly on board at the cruise director only. You will get a brief description together with your travel documents. Depending on the number of participants some

excursions could be carried out in 2 languages (German/ English). **Luggage** We recommend: rainwear, bicycle helmet, sunhat and sneakers. **Schedule and program changes** Basically, we reserve the right to make changes of routing and program. In case of flood or low tide, the shipping company reserves the right to bridge parts of passages by buses. In extreme situations, the shipping company reserves the right to cancel the journey on short notice. No legal right shall be constituted of both situations. The same applies for officially ordered - previously not announced - repair work on locks or bridges. **Notes** Please be aware that a cruise ship is not only your hotel but also a machine, working with engine power also during the night. Especially crossing locks and bridges - and the preparation work - may cause noise. If you are sensitive please bring your own ear plugs. **Digital Travel documents and roadmaps:** In the interest of sustainability and climate protection, please choose our digital route book instead of printed travel documents. The GUIBO app is your constant companion during your SE-Tours original trip. A glance at your smartphone is enough to keep you safe and worry-free, with all the important information at hand. Travel information, ship and contact details and your bike tours are available digitally in the route book, available offline and thus accessible at any time. The app is available for free and works on all standard smartphones. You will automatically receive the access data to download your booked trip via email before your journey begins. **Travel documents** EU-citizens (without special situations like dual citizenship, main residence abroad or a limited-validity passport) are required to have a valid passport or ID-card, not expiring within six (6) months of the return of your cruise. We kindly ask non-EU citizens, EU-nationals with multiple citizenship or anybody who has to respect special legal entry requirements for the country to visit, to inform about visa and entry documents at the competent embassy. **This trip is not suitable for guests with reduced mobility.** We recommend that **you take out a travel health insurance with repatriation coverage as well as baggage, accident and travel cancellation insurances**
